



Adaptation

Investigate how a range of animals and plants are adapted to live in different environments such as desert, savannah and rainforest.

Classification

Learn more about how and why we classify animals, using our large collection of skull specimens to compare similarities and differences between species.

Training and Enrichment

Find out how and why we train some of the animals at the Zoo, learn about operant conditioning and watch some of the training in action. Explore some of the forms of enrichment we give various animals, discover why it is so important.

Endangered Animals and Conservation

Learn about the threats to animals in the wild and what zoos are doing to conserve them both in the zoo and in their natural habitat.

Evolution

Explore the theory of evolution and natural selection in a range of species from different environments. A chance to get a closer look at our large collection of specimens to illustrate various adaptations and compare skulls in a range of species.

Business and Marketing

What do we do at the zoo? From the structure and budgets of the business, strategy and marketing to conservation and looking after our endangered animals.

Sustainability: Sussed?

What are solutions to the environmental crisis we find ourselves in today? During this session we look at the main consumer choices that we make every day from fashion to food, and how we might manage the earth's valuable resources in the future. Towards the end of the session the focus will be on food and participants will get to try some edible invertebrates. *

Climate Crisis

Our climate is changing, and this poses many challenges, for wildlife, for wild places, and for us as a society. Understand the science behind climate change and discover what it means for us and for the species here at the zoo. Discover what we can all do to make a difference, and see that the choices we make can have a real impact.
