Multiplication and division – how many feet?

- ◆ Through a gap in the bars, Jim the zoo keeper can see 16 feet. How many giraffes are there?
- ◆ Jo the bird keeper is making socks for our flock of flamingos! How many feet do our 13 flamingos have?
- ◆ Jay has found 6 of our lizards and 3 snakes in the reptile house. How many legs do the animals have?
- ◆ Each of our lions eats 3 chunks of meat each week. If we had 6 lions how many chunks of meat do we need to buy this week?

Measurement:

Here is a picture of Joanna, one of our female giraffes, next to Jim. How tall is Joanna?

- ◆ Jim is almost 2 metres (6 feet) tall.
- ◆ Each brick is 30cm (1 foot) in height

More or Less:

Our longest snake is a reticulated python called Nagini.

- ◆ She is 12 years old and 5 metres long
Is this longer or shorter than you?
Older or younger?
- ◆ Our lions can sleep for 16 hours each day.
Is this more or less than you?
